

SuperWASP

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In SuperWASP (Wide Angle Search for Planets) we observe almost the entire sky looking for extrasolar planets transiting their parent stars. Although we are currently sensitive to Hot Jupiters and have confirmed detection of two to date, it may also be possible to detect smaller planets and at greater orbital separation.

Presented here are our very latest results including planetary candidates, follow-up observations, confirmed planet detections and attempts to characterize these confirmed planets.
